

**ONE-YEAR POST-DOCTORAL POSITION**  
***Laboratoire de Psychologie Sociale et Cognitive, Clermont-Ferrand (France)***

**Culture, communication & extremism**

As a partner of the interdisciplinary project FUTURICT.2 that received financial support for 5 years (2017-2021), the Laboratory for Social and Cognitive Psychology (LAPSCO) at the University of Clermont- Ferrand, France, invites applications for an Agence Nationale de la Recherche (ANR)-funded postdoctoral fellowship position. FUTURICT.2 is led by an Italian research team and involves 8 laboratories around the world, including LAPSCO and LISC (Laboratory for Complex Systems) both located in the Clermont-Ferrand area.

Clermont-Ferrand is a mid-size city in the center of France, best known for its quality of life (#1 in 2017) and home to one of the best research centers in social psychology.

**The position consists of a full-time 12-month fellowship starting on October 1st 2017 at the latest. Funding is also available for research and travel related to the project.**

The fellow will work on ongoing projects in collaboration with partners (mainly researchers from LAPSCO, lead investigator: Serge Guimond). The topics of investigation broadly concern issues related to culture, new communication networks and extremism. The aim is to contribute to an interdisciplinary analysis of the major changes and challenges facing the world today (climate change, social conflicts, radicalisation). The postdoctoral fellow's primary tasks will be to coordinate empirical studies, analyse data, prepare research papers and reports, and related tasks.

The applicant should hold a Ph.D. in psychology that was obtained during the last three years. Applicants should have a strong background in social psychology and research methods (including laboratory experiment). Moreover, excellent data analysis skills and working knowledge of French and English are required for the position. Please provide a Curriculum Vitae and an application letter detailing your motivation, your research theme of interest, and the names and e-mails of three experts who can provide a recommendation letter for you (pdf version is required).
